<i>Exudes bright berry characteristics with notes of cloves & spice. The palate is soft & generous with an abundance of fruit & velvety tannins to finish.</i>

Chateau des Gravieres, Cuvée Rubis (13%) – 2015	Bordeaux, France	£28.00
<i>Full of finesse & freshness with emerging red fruits. The barrel ageing gives rise to great complexity with cedar undertones on the nose. The feel of soft tannins with a long & luscious length.</i>		
Pinot Noir Gran Reserve, Novas (14.5%) – 2016	Chile	£29.50
<i>Bright cherry fruit Pinot Noir from the cool climate Casablanca Valley. Soft tannins and good acidity combine to form a fine finish. Suitable for vegans.</i>		
Lodi Zinfandel, Ravenswood (14.5%) – 2014	California, USA	£31.00
<i>Bursting with luscious flavours of blackberry & black cherry, aromas of chocolate & spice, and balanced acidity.</i>		
Amancaya, Catena/Rothschild (14.5%) – 2015	Mendoza, Argentina	£34.50
