- Chenin Blanc, George Kinross (12.5%) – 2015** South Africa **£15.50**
South African Chenin is fresh and vibrant with hints of almonds, white flower flavours with a light citrus finish.
- Sauvignon Blanc, Isabella da Silva (12.5%) – 2016** Chile **£17.00**
Fruity, fresh nose with pleasant citrus and green apple, gooseberry and grapefruit flavour. A refreshing Sauvignon Blanc from one of Chile's most notable producers; Vina la Rosa, who make consistently award winning wines.
- Pinot Grigio, Principato (12%) - 2015** Italy **£18.00**
Delicate, floral & fruity aromas. Crisp palate with citrus characters and a slightly spicy finish.
- Chardonnay, Comtesse de Marion (13%) – 2015** Languedoc, France **£19.50**
A fifth generation family producer making estate-grown wines from their own vineyards in the Languedoc. Fresh and fruity, this Chardonnay is unoaked and is fabulous with fish!
- Picpoul de Pinet, Duc de Morny (12.5%) – 2015** Languedoc, France **£21.50**
Slightly perfumed ripe melon fruit on the nose. The palate is weighty and ripe but remains vibrant and fresh. Suitable for vegans.
- Sauvignon Blanc, The Cloud Factory (13%) – 2015** Marlborough, N.Z. **£23.00**
A bright and vibrant wine, perfumed with nettle ripe tropical fruits, which are also evident on the palate. Fresh flavours and a rich minerality produce a clean, fresh and delicious wine!
- Mâcon-Charnay, Réserve Personelle (13.5%) – 2015** Burgundy, France **£24.50**
Classic unoaked white Burgundy with great depth and weight. Lemon aroma on the nose, bright palate: white stone fruits with a squeeze of lime. Pairs well with grilled or baked fish as well as chicken dishes.
- Albarino, Esencia Divina (12.5%) - 2015** Spain **£26.00**
Spain's greatest white grape variety. Floral and ripe peach aromas. These vineyards are within sight of the Atlantic Ocean and take on some of its salinity making it a perfect match for seafood.
- Chablis, La Colombe (12.5%) – 2014** Burgundy, France **£29.00**
Unoaked, flinty on the nose with a touch of creamy fruit underneath, this gets richer as the mineral characters give way to a gently fruity core, then cut back by a long juicy bite.
- Pouilly Fuissé, Dom. Philippe Charmond (13%) – 2014** Burgundy, France **£32.00**
Weightier Chardonnay fruit with lemon and butterscotch notes – a hint of toasted, vanillin character under the mineral fruit of lemons, apricots and peaches.

<i>Cherry coloured with an intense nose of strawberries, cloves & coffee. Round and lively with a touch of wild strawberries & vanilla on the palate. Medium bodied with a hint of smokiness on the finish.</i>		
Black Shiraz, Richland (14.5%) - 2015	Australia	£21.50
<i>Bramble fruits and a touch of smokiness with great body and structure. A distinct cracked black pepper finish.</i>		
La Balade, Minervois Aurelie Vic (14%) - 2014	France	£23.00
<i>A stunning blend of Mourvèdre, Syrah, Grenache and Carignan that expresses the 'garrigue' (herbaceous notes) of the Languedoc along with bags of black fruit. It's rich, full and generous.</i>		
Rioja Reserve, Finca Besaya (13.5%) - 2010	Spain	£25.50
<i>Blackberries on the nose, spiced notes and great structure, an elegant finish of toasted wood and toffee.</i>		
Chateau de Sours, Bordeaux (13.5%) - 2010	Bordeaux, France	£28.00
<i>Aromas of dark fruits, soft and silky palate with an elegant finish. Chateau de Sours originally dates back to the 14th century, when it served as an inn on the pilgrims route to Santiago de Compostella, in North West Spain.</i>		
Amancaya, Catena/Rothschild (14.5%) - 2012	Mendoza, Argentina	£33.00
<i>Malbec - Cabernet Sauvignon. Generous dark fruit with great complexity. The expertise from a Bordeaux First Growth Chateau (Rothschilds of Lafite) with one of Argentina's finest wine producers (Dr Nicolas Catena).</i>
